Thermal Belt Outreach Ministry is accepting applications for two summer interns to work 32 hours per week. To apply, students must be at least 16 years old, enrolled in school (or an accredited home school program) and be a rising sophomore, junior, or senior. Applicants must reside in Polk County or Landrum (zip code 29356).

Successful candidates will demonstrate personal maturity and willingness to learn, and strong work ethic in order to meet the challenges of working in a professional environment. They must also be able to articulate the mission and purpose of Outreach.

Job Description:



The interns will work in our home repair program under the supervision of Dave Graham of the Foothills Housing Partnership. The goal of the Outreach home repair program is to correct housing conditions for low-income residents that impact safety, mobility, or efficiency. Project examples include floor and decking repairs, roof repair, window replacement, minor plumbing and well repairs, and handicap ramps.

This position requires an understanding of building trades, the ability to follow directions, a considerable level of physical activity, and the ability to lift up to 50 lbs.
